- The purpose of the REP Recovery Initiative is to strengthen recovery capabilities within the REP community.
- FEMA THD HQ is able to support the development of various events through coordinated planning efforts and engagement with key stakeholders.

Recovery Initiative Significance

- Aligns with the need for further emphasis on recovery planning to ensure a well-rounded preparedness effort
- Develops and improves relationships between agencies not typically engaged
- Directly supports three FEMA Strategic Priorities
 - Strategic Goal 1: Build a Culture of Preparedness
 - Strategic Goal 2: Ready the Nation for Catastrophic Disasters
 - Strategic Goal 3: Reduce the Complexity of FEMA

Recovery Initiative Events

Recovery Seminars

- Briefings/Presentations can be designed or tailored to the target audience and desired outcomes
- Facilitated discussion designed for specific topics with desired level of scenario detail
- Potential areas for discussion:
 - Economic Recovery
 - Housing
 - Operational Coordination
- Presentations can be coupled with high level discussions related to specific core capabilities
- Potential presentation topics:
 - USDA Panel
 - FEMA Response
 - Price Anderson Act

Level of Planning:

Low/Medium: Level of pre-exercise engagement will depend on the desired areas for discussion and the level of scenario detail. Will require engagement with regional/state representatives for coordinating presenters, reviewing materials, developing scenario materials, and presenting/facilitating.



Ingestion/Post-Plume Seminars

- Serves as a platform for discussing ingestion/post-plume concepts in advance of the ingestion exercise
- Can be coupled with additional training and presentations to serve as a federal outreach
- Initiative events can be tailored to meet the following ingestion pathway and post-plume phase drill activities:
 - Assessment of the impact on foodstuffs and agricultural products
 - Protective decisions for reentry, relocation, return, and reoccupancy
 - Foodstuffs/crop embargo
 - Dissemination of ingestion exposure pathway EPZ information to pre-determined individuals and business
 - Identification of the individual authorized to make decisions in the ingestion exposure pathway EPZ
