NUREG-0654/FEMA-REP-1, Rev. 2

- FEMA NRC Joint guidance document
 - Being updated for the first time since 1980.
 - In the last stages of concurrence
- Final vetting nearing completion between both agencies.
- Document currently at OMB
 - Estimate completion by OMB 2 Qtr 2019
- Upon completion at OMB, the document will go to the FEMA Administrator for FEMA final sign off.

NUREG-0654/FEMA-REP-1, Rev. 2

Cont'd

- As a minimum, the following complimentary documents will assist implementation of NUREG-0645/FEMA-REP-1, Rev. 2 when it is finalized:
 - Change Summary – very high-level review of changes made.
 - Adjudication Report – disposition and adjudication response for every comment provided during the 2015 public comment period.
 - Crosswalk – correlate changes from Rev. 1 to Rev. 2 in a chart for ease of use/understanding.
 - IS Course – will address the changes made between the two revisions and provide some discussion regarding the motivation behind the changes. The intention is for the IS Course to be a review of the changes for FEMA staff and stakeholders, and a stopgap measure for planners until the planning course can be updated. Once the planning course is updated, the information within the IS Course will be folded into the Core Concepts courses and the Planning Course.

Regulations

- 44 CFR 350-354 revision
 - Draft Redlines of all 5 regulations are complete and finishing review by OCC Regulatory affairs
 - Will be sharing with NRC for initial review Feb 2019
 - Public comment is anticipated the summer of 2019.



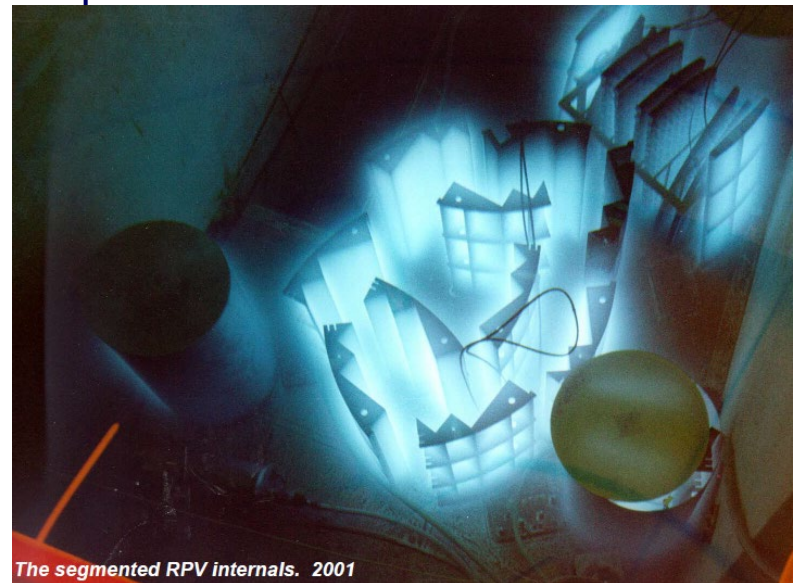
