# Course Description



# SCEMD

This course focuses on the review of offsite response organizations' radiological emergency preparedness (REP) plans and procedures utilizing the 16 planning standards (from 44 CFR Part 350 and 10 CFR § 50.47) and associated evaluation criteria (from NUREG 0654/FEMA-REP-1, Rev.1) which address protecting the health and safety of the public when responding during the plume phase of a radiological emergency at an NRC-licensed commercial nuclear power plant. The RPPR course will include training based on the Comprehensive Preparedness Guide (CPG)-101, annual plan reviews, and the Annual Letter of Certification (ALC) Review Guide process.

# Course Description



# SCEMD

The purpose of this course is to provide emergency managers, from Offsite Response Organizations (ORO) within the 10 or 50-mile Emergency Planning Zones (EPZs) of a NRC-licensed commercial nuclear power plant, with the fundamental knowledge of the Preliminary Capabilities Assessment (PCA) or if warranted the Disaster Initiated Review (DIR) process, as referenced in the FEMA Radiological Emergency Preparedness (REP) Program Disaster Initiated Review (DIR) Standard Operating Guide (SOG), Post-Disaster Assessment of Offsite Capabilities Checklists, and the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Inspection Manual (IM) Chapter 1601.
