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Executive Summary

On July 13, 2022, a Plume exercise was conducted in the 10-mile plume exposure pathway, emergency planning zone (EPZ) around the Robert E. Ginna Nuclear Power Station by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), Region II. The purpose of the exercise and the out-of-sequence demonstrations was to assess the level of State and local preparedness in responding to a radiological emergency. The exercise and out-of-sequence demonstrations were held in accordance with FEMA's policies and guidance concerning the exercise of State and local radiological emergency response plans (RERP) and procedures.

The most recent prior full-scale exercise at this site was conducted on August 20-21, 2019, this postponement exercise was rescheduled from July 2021. The qualifying emergency preparedness exercise was conducted on January 21, 1982.

FEMA wishes to acknowledge the efforts of the many individuals in the State of New York and the risk jurisdictions of Monroe and Wayne Counties who were evaluated at this exercise. Protecting the public health and safety is the full-time job of some of the exercise participants and an additional assigned responsibility for others. Still others have willingly sought this responsibility by volunteering to provide vital emergency services to their communities. Cooperation and teamwork of all the participants were evident during this exercise.

Section 2: Exercise Design Summary

2.1 Exercise Purpose and Design

The DHS/FEMA Region II Office evaluated the exercise on July 13, 2022 to assess the capabilities of the local emergency preparedness organizations in implementing their Radiological Emergency Response Plans and Procedures to protect the public health and safety during a radiological emergency involving Robert E. Ginna Nuclear Power Plant (Ginna). The purpose of this report is to present the results of the findings on the performance of the offsite response organizations during a simulated radiological emergency.

2.2 Exercise Core Capabilities and Objectives

Core capabilities-based planning allows for exercise planning teams to develop exercise objectives and observe exercise outcomes through a framework of specific action items. Using the Homeland Security Exercise and Evaluation Program methodology, the exercise objectives meet the Radiological Emergency Preparedness Program requirements and encompass the emergency preparedness evaluation areas.

The core capabilities scheduled for demonstration during this exercise were:

Operational Coordination: Establish and maintain a unified and coordinated operational structure and process that appropriately integrates all critical stakeholders and supports the execution of core capabilities.

Environmental Response/Health and Safety: Conduct appropriate measures to ensure the protection of the health and safety of the public and workers, as well as the environment, from all-hazards in support of responder operations and the affected communities.

Mass Care Services: Provide life-sustaining and human services to the affected population, to include hydration, feeding, sheltering, temporary housing, evacuee support, reunification, and distribution of emergency supplies.

Operational Communications: Ensure the capacity for timely communications in support of security, situational awareness, and operations by any and all means available, among and between affected communities in the impact area and all response forces.

Public Health, Healthcare, and Emergency Medical Services: Provide lifesaving medical treatment via Emergency Medical Services and related operations and avoid additional disease and injury by providing targeted public health, medical, and behavioral health support, and products to all affected populations.

Situational Assessment: Provide all decision makers with decision-relevant information regarding the nature and extent of the hazard, any cascading effects, and the status of the response.

Public Information and Warning: Deliver coordinated, prompt, reliable, and actionable information to the whole community through the use of clear, consistent, accessible, and culturally and linguistically appropriate methods to effectively relay

information regarding any threat or hazard, as well as the actions being taken and the assistance being made available, as appropriate.

Intelligence and Information Sharing: Provide timely, accurate, and actionable information resulting from the planning, direction, collection, exploitation, processing, analysis, production, dissemination, evaluation, and feedback of available information concerning physical and cyber threats to the United States, its people, property, or interests; the development, proliferation, or use of WMDs; or any other matter bearing on U.S. national or homeland security by local, state, tribal, territorial, Federal, and other stakeholders. Information sharing is the ability to exchange intelligence, information, data, or knowledge among government or private sector entities, as appropriate.

Critical Transportation: Provide transportation (including infrastructure access and accessible transportation services) for response priority objectives, including the evacuation of people and animals, and the delivery of vital response personnel, equipment, and services into the affected areas.

Infrastructure Systems: Stabilize critical infrastructure functions, minimize health and safety threats, and efficiently restore and revitalize systems and services to support a viable, resilient community.

On-scene Security, Protection, and Law Enforcement: Ensure a safe and secure environment through law enforcement and related security and protection operations for people and communities located within affected areas and also for response personnel engaged in lifesaving and life-sustaining operations.

2.3 Exercise Scenario

0800 – Exercise begins. Winds are from 53° at 12.0 mph with Stability Class D (towards Wayne & Monroe Counties). Unit online at 100% power, for 182 days.

0805 – Loss of Offsite Power causes reactor trip. Emergency Diesel Generator (EDG) Alpha immediately trips offline. Emergency Diesel Generator Bravo starts and runs normally, supplying power to safeguards busses.

0820 – Alert Emergency Classification Level (ECL) Main Control Room, Shift Manager, declares based on Emergency Action Level (EAL) MA1, AC power capability to safeguards buses reduced to only one power source for > 15 minutes.

0945 – Remaining Emergency Diesel Generator Bravo trips off.

1000 – Site Area Emergency ECL Station Emergency Coordinator declares based on Emergency Action Level (EAL) MS1, Loss of all offsite and onsite power to safeguards busses for > 15 minutes.

1100 – Reactor Containment building penetration fails. Unfiltered, unmonitored radiological release begins. Winds are from 53° at 12.0 mph with Stability Class D (towards Wayne & Monroe Counties). PAGs are not exceeded.

1115 – Report to Ginna from repair teams, EDG Bravo repairs will take 5 hours.

1130 – General Emergency ECL Station Emergency Director declares based on Emergency Action Level (EAL) MG1, Loss of all offsite and onsite power to safeguards busses and power not likely to be restored in < 4 hours. The Corporate Emergency Director will recommend a default PAR: 1) evacuate and implement the KI plan for all Emergency Response Planning Areas (ERPA) within the 2-Mile Emergency Planning Zone (EPZ) and 2) evacuate and implement the KI plan for all Emergency Response Planning Areas (ERPA) within the downwind 5-Mile Emergency Planning Zone (EPZ) and 3) all remaining ERPAs monitor and prepare.

1155 – Significant increase in radiological release. EPA PAGs will be exceeded.

1230 – Onsite EndEx. Ginna portion of evaluation is complete, simulator continues to run and key players in roles for continued state and county play.

Section 3: Analysis of Capabilities**3.1 Exercise Evaluation and Results**

This section contains the results and findings of the evaluation of all jurisdictions and functional entities that participated in the July 13, 2022 Plume Phase, Robert E. Ginna 2021.

Each jurisdiction and functional entity was evaluated based on the demonstration of core capabilities, capability targets, critical tasks, and the underlying Radiological Emergency Preparedness criteria as delineated in the Federal Emergency Management Agency Radiological Emergency Preparedness Program Manual dated January 2016. Exercise criteria are listed by number, and the demonstration status of those criteria are indicated by the use of the following terms:

- Met (M): No Findings assessed and no unresolved Findings from prior exercises.

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- Level 1 (L1) Finding: An observed or identified inadequacy of organizational performance in an exercise that could cause a determination that offsite emergency preparedness is not adequate to provide reasonable assurance that appropriate protective measures can be taken in the event of a radiological emergency to protect the health and safety of the public living in the vicinity of a Nuclear Power Plant (NPP).
- Level 2 (L2) Finding: An observed or identified inadequacy of organizational performance in an exercise that is not considered, by itself, to adversely impact public health and safety.
- Plan (P) Issue: An observed or identified inadequacy in the offsite response organizations' (ORO's) emergency plan/implementing procedures, rather than that of the ORO's performance.
- N: Not demonstrated
