Good morning Cindy,

The ALC submission looks great. Only a couple of minor items that I need to complete the review.

For the SONGS Letter of Certification Report - on the area of "Update Plans/Procedures and Letters of Agreements" (page 4-5) do you have an LOA done with San Diego County? I have one on file from 2004. Additionally, I also need a copy of the one done with the CHP.

For DCPs Letter of Certification Report, page 7, #6 comment box * "See attached spreadsheet for KI Locations." I did not find the referenced spreadsheet - could you also forward this.

Lastly, just a comment on an area that would help us expedite the process with the DCP submission in the area of training. Please reference the SONGS report - "2013 Radiological Emergency Preparedness Training" on how their matrix of training was formatted.

For DCP, the attachment " 2013 Offsite Emergency Worker Training Summary for Diablo Canyon Power Plant" has dates and attendance, but for the type of training - well the description "classroom" is a bit vague.

On the other hand the DCP Letter of Certification Report list the types of training (page 4). However, some of the dates that the training was held do not match those listed on the attachment. So in essence, it's a bit of "jumping around" to verify.

Just asking that future submissions to follow the same format as in the SONGS report.
