The Department of Homeland Security/Federal Emergency Management Agency (DHS/FEMA) Region 6 received the Louisiana 2020 Annual Letter of Certification (ALC) of Radiological Emergency Preparedness (REP) program activities. These items summarize REP activities in Louisiana, as documented by the detailed examples provided by your office, for the State of Louisiana.

The FEMA Region 6 staff reviewed the contents of the ALC against criteria provided in our guidance documents, Radiological Emergency Preparedness Program Manual, dated January 2016 concerning ALC reporting requirements. Based upon compliance with NUREG-0654/FEMA REP-I, 44 CFR 350, and the Radiological Emergency Preparedness Program Manual, your ALC will remain on file in the DHS/FEMA Region 6 office as verification that the outlined activities have been successfully accomplished. I want to emphasize the importance of the ALC, since this information is part of what FEMA uses in making reasonable assurance findings and determinations on offsite radiological emergency plans and preparedness.
