The Department of Homeland Security's Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Region 6 has received and reviewed Texas' 2023 Annual Letter of Certification (ALC) for its Radiological Emergency Preparedness (REP) program. The ALC details the State of Texas' REP activities for the past year.
