Item 1- II: Public Education and Information, 5.d. Description of program

Description: Media center location is not listed in the media kit information.

Reference(s): NUREG-0654/FEMA-REP-1, Evaluation Criterion G.5 “Each organization shall conduct coordinated programs at least annually to acquaint news media with the emergency plans, information concerning radiation, and points of contact for release of public information in an emergency.”

To meet the intent of Criterion G.5. ORO Plans/Procedures shall describe:

i. Provisions for an annual media briefing.

ii. Distribution of written materials (media kits) covering topics described below.

iii. Each item provided as baseline information about REP to the local media.

OROs hold an annual briefing, workshop, mailing, or other means of providing information to news media on the following topics:

- An overview of the joint information system and emergency plans/procedures, including organizational roles and authorities, ECLs, and protective actions.
- **Points of contact and locations for release of public information during an emergency, including media center locations and alternate facilities, as well as telephone numbers for media inquiries.**
- General information concerning radiation exposure and health effects, as well as the distribution and use of KI by the general public, as appropriate.

Corrective Action(s): Wolf Creek maintains this document and will ensure the 2021 revision of the media kits include the above information.

Item 2- III: Radiological Emergency Response Training, 1.a. All required organizations were offered training pursuant to ORO plans/procedures

Description: Per the ALC, “Due to the response required for the pandemic KDEM was not able to offer annual training.”

Reference(s): NUREG-0654/FEMA-REP-1, Evaluation Criterion O.5 “Each organization shall provide for the initial and annual retraining of personnel with emergency response responsibilities.”

Corrective Action(s): Training is required to be conducted virtually at this time due to the pandemic. With additional considerations based upon the fact that most agencies that would be participating in the training are currently involved in the active COVID-19 response it has been decided that a pre-recorded training made available to all partners will be the best approach to satisfy this requirement.
