The Oregon State report on the Periodic Requirements and Annual Letter of Certification dated January 19, 2021, for calendar year 2020, is hereby approved. The State of Oregon and the affected local jurisdictions' response plans, drills, and preparedness measures provide reasonable assurance that appropriate measures can be taken to protect the health and safety of the public in the event of a radiological emergency. Therefore, 44 CFR Part 350 approval of the offsite radiological emergency response plans and preparedness for the State of Oregon, site-specific to the Columbia Generating Station, will remain in effect.
